Handy Hints

Always set your tent up before leaving on your trip to make sure that you have all the necessary parts. It is ideal to place a ground sheet down before erecting your tent as this will ensure longevity of your tent floor. A poly tarp is ideal for this.

Make sure your tent is dry before packing it away and store in a dry place in order to prevent possible mildew damage and odour. Never set up your tent or swag close to a camp fire area or where sparks from a camp fire may blow onto your tent or swag. Be aware of the weather conditions and make sure not to set up a tent underneath trees in windy conditions.
