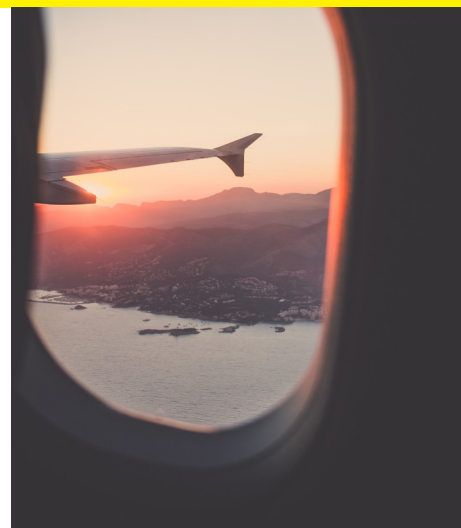

When travelling overseas, make sure you know where your Country Embassy is and to register on Smart Traveller.gov.au

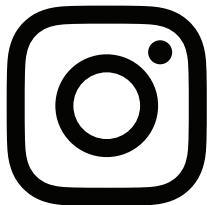
Keep yourself informed on current events and alerts that might affect your trip and travel. Track down free Wifi spots and keep family and friends updated on your travel plans.

Before you leave, organise necessary credit, debit and travel money cards, and register for internet banking so you can keep track spending while you're away.

Also consider travel insurance, traveller's cheques and make sure your passport is valid for at least 6 months. Photocopy important documents such as your passport, driver's licenses and other ID, keeping copies at the bottom of your pack incase the originals are stolen.
